## Matching pictures

1. Double bass because it's standing but accept Cello because both the cello and the bass rest on a spike.
2. Bass drum – as played in a marching band. A pop group's bass drum has a foot pedal.
3. A grand piano. Accept a harpsichord.
4. A snare or side drum. Toy soldiers have one strapped around their shoulder. Timpani look like this



5. One of a pair of maracas. A guiro has indentations and you scrape a stick along it.
6. Clarinet. In an oboe the shape of the open end is different and you can see the double reed in the mouthpiece.
7. Flute or piccolo. Primitive version as a real flute has a complicated set of keys covering the holes.
8. Trumpet. A French Horn looks like this
